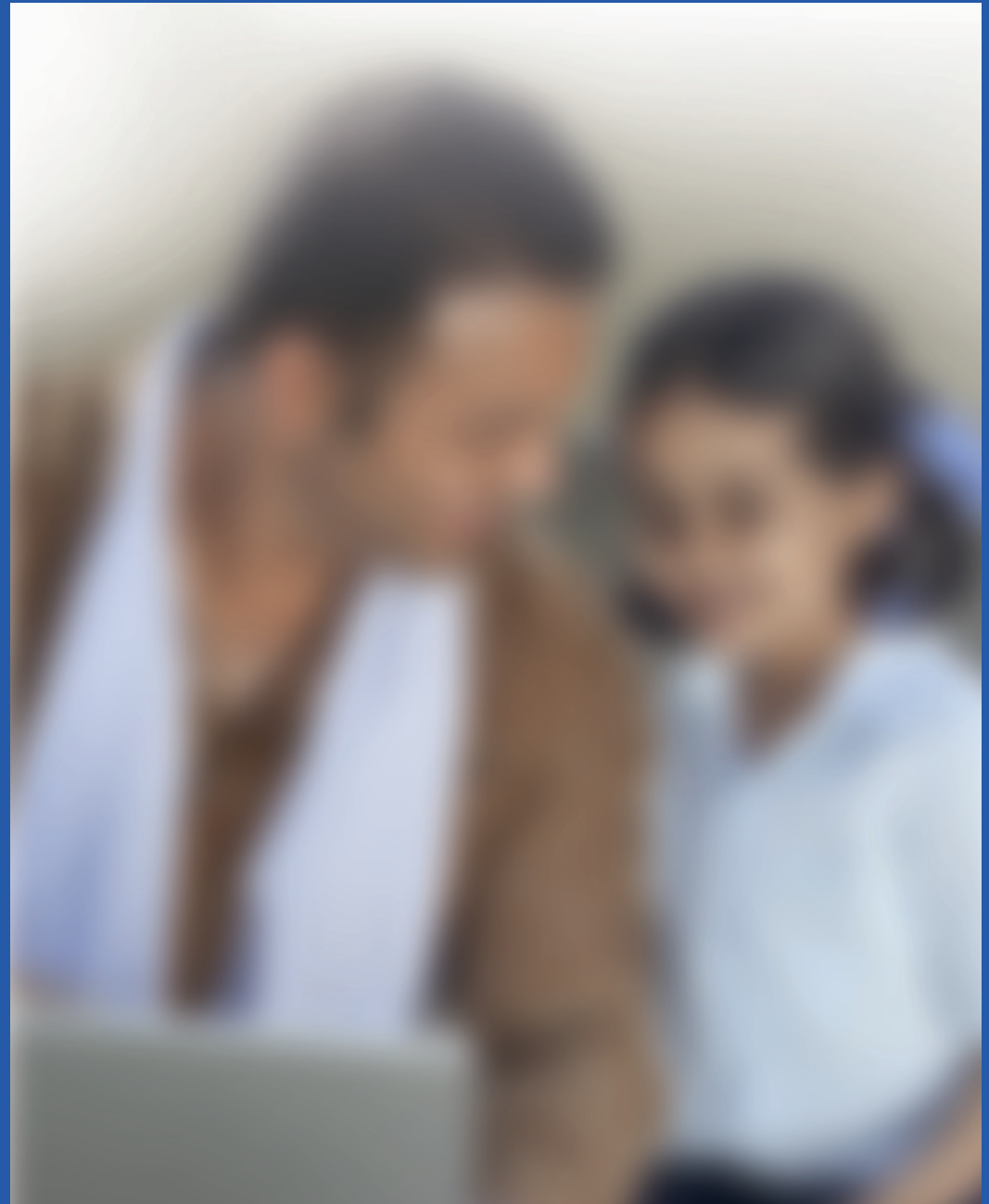


IS DIABETES CHANGING HOW YOUR WORLD LOOKS?
